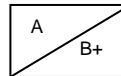

Please complete the worksheet by typing or printing clearly.

1. **Course Number.** Enter the department and number designation for the course as found on your transcript or in the college catalog. **Include courses that you still need to take/complete.**
2. **Title.** Enter the course title as written on your transcript or in the college catalog.
3. **Grade.** Enter the grade you received for each completed course as recorded on your transcript including plus [+] or minus [-]. We do not accept pass/fail grades or grades less than C (2.0) for pre-requisite coursework. Both grades must be entered for courses with separate lecture and lab components (you may split the boxes as shown):



4. **Grade Points.** Enter grade value points as listed in the following chart

A = 4.0	B+ = 3.3	B- = 2.7	C = 2.0
A - = 3.7	B = 3.0	C + = 2.3	

5. **Semester Hours.** Enter the semester credit hours assigned to the course. **If you took courses on the quarter hour system, convert quarter hours to semester hours by dividing quarter hours by 1.5.** Example: 4 quarter hours / 1.5 = 2.6 semester hours.
6. **Total Points Earned.** Multiply your grade points (1) by the semester hour credit (2) to get total points earned (3). Example: In *Phys 101 General Physics I* for 4 credits you received an A- equal to 3.7 grade points or $3.7 \times 4 = 14.8$ total points earned. **For repeated courses, we will accept the higher of the two grades.**
7. **College.** Enter the initials of the college at which you took the course.
8. **Date Completed.** Enter the term in which you completed or will complete the course, e.g., Fall 2009.
9. **Transcript.** Indicate whether or not you have included an unofficial copy of your transcript (typically called a student copy).
10. **Total.** Total the semester hours column (2) and the total points earned column (3) in the space provided.
11. **Pre-requisite GPA.** Divide the total points earned (3) by the total credits (2) for all completed coursework.
