Rome Experience Refund Policy

Application and Program Fees

Your \$200 application fee is nonrefundable after the application deadline. Cancellation after the application deadline will result in your responsibility for any unrecoverable expenses incurred by Walsh on your behalf. Should Walsh cancel a program prior to departure, a full refund will be issued. Should Walsh terminate a program in progress, all program payments to Walsh less non-recoverable expenses will be refunded. If you leave or are expelled from the program for any reason, there will be no refund of fees already paid and you are responsible for your return transportation home.

Tuition

The same tuition and fee refund policy for our main campus will apply. As a result, it will depend on *when* you withdraw from the program. If you withdraw during the fall add/drop period (as determined and published by the Registrar) you will not be charged the tuition and fee component and your financial aid will be backed off of your account. If you withdraw from the program *after* the add/drop period, then you will be charged full tuition and fees, HOWEVER, your financial aid will be prorated based on when exactly you withdrew (per federal regulations).

Important: if you attend the second Fall session of the Rome experience that does not start until October, you must still adhere to the main campus withdraw policies as published in the Walsh University catalogue. Accordingly, you have six business days from the start of the fall semester, not from your October trip date, to withdraw with a full refund.

Room and Board

The same room and board refund policy for our main campus will apply:

1. A grace period of six business days is provided at the beginning of the semester during which a student may receive a full room and board refund upon withdrawal as a resident student. Notification of withdrawal must be made in writing to the Residence Life Office by the deadline. No refund of room/board charges will be made after the seventh business day.
2. No refunds will be made when the student is required to leave the University for disciplinary and/or academic reasons.

Important: if you attend the second Fall session of the Rome experience that does not start until October, you must still adhere to the main campus withdraw policies as published in the Walsh University catalogue. Accordingly, you have six business days from the start of the fall semester, not from your October trip date, to withdraw with a full refund.
