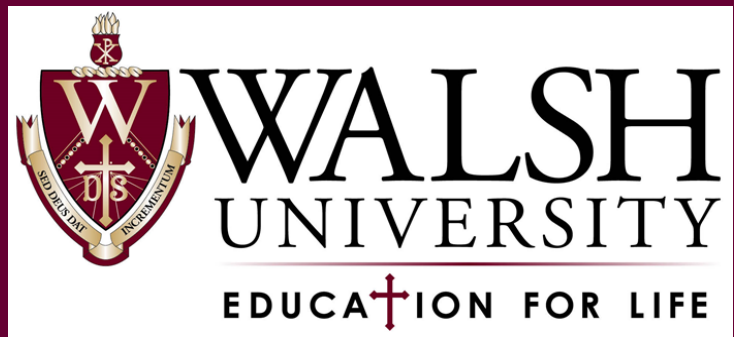
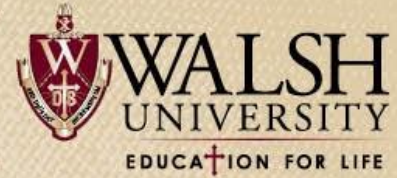

What is Financial Aid?



Financial Aid is:

- Funds that come from: federal, state, your school, and private sources to help cover the costs of your education.
- A Cost of Attendance is a budget created to include all potential estimated costs for attending school. This includes tuition, fees, housing, meals, personal expenses, transportation, books, and supplies.

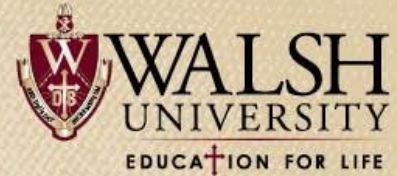

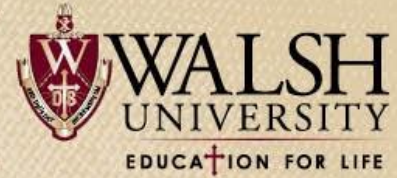

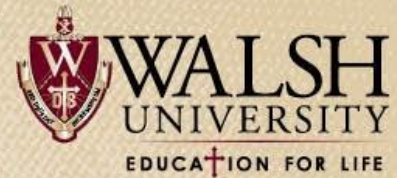
Financial Aid Offer

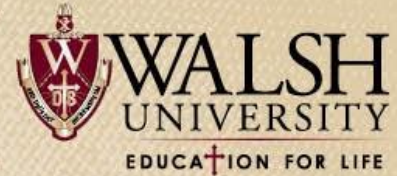

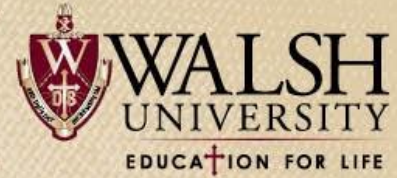

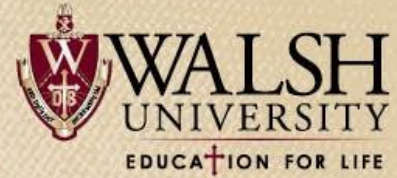

- Remaining balance is the amount that you are required to pay to Walsh University; however, amount may be divided into two installments or a monthly payment plan.
- First payment will be due **August 31, 2026** (first business day after add/drop)



Financial Aid Steps



1. VIEW YOUR FINANCIAL AID

- Log into the Cav Center through **walsh.edu**
- Click "Students"
- Click the 4 white squares in upper left corner
- Click Banner
- Click Financial Aid
- View 26/27 Award Year
- If you do not see an award, check to see if you are missing any requirements

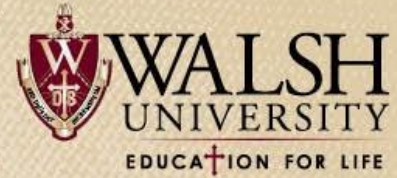
2. ACCEPT OR DECLINE LOANS

- You will see drop down boxes to accept or decline your loans and/or work-study

3. VIEW YOUR BILL/AMOUNT DUE

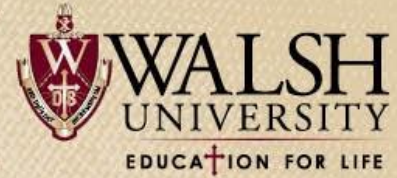
- Click the 4 white squares in upper left corner

- You can make payments, set up payment plans and manage refunds here

4. OUTSTANDING REQUIREMENTS

- To complete MPN or Entrance Counseling, please do so on **studentaid.gov**
- Your loans will not post until this is done

5. MISSING FORMS

- Any missing forms can be turned in 3 ways:
- Through our secure online portal, emailed to **studentservicecenter@walsh.edu**, or turned into the SSC in Farrell Hall room 101

6. TIPS TO HELP

- Check your Walsh email often; any emails from SSC will be important
- Check your Nelnet Student Account often to make sure your account is paid up to date

*Future CAV: It is important to regularly monitor your student Walsh University email account.




Financial Aid Next Steps

Accept or Decline your loans

- Subsidized loan- A federal student loan, where the government pays the interest while the student is enrolled at least half-time.
- Unsubsidized loan- A federal student loan, where interest begins accruing upon disbursement.

Direct Loan Requirements

- Complete Loan Entrance Counseling
- Electronically sign your Master Promissory Note (MPN)

- Federal loan in the parent's name. Detailed information and the application are available on studentaid.gov


Parent Plus Loan Limits

- Walsh offers a site to view alternative loan options.

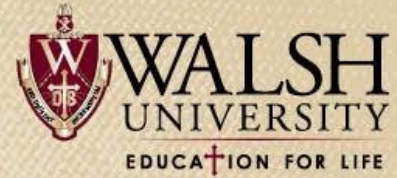

Federal Work Study/Campus Service

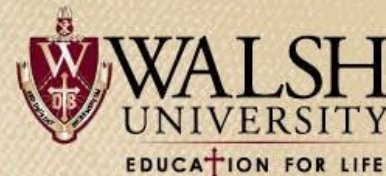


What is Federal Work Study aid:

- Work up to 10 hours per week on campus.
- Paychecks are issued once a month.
- Please note: The financial aid offer may contain a certain amount allocated for work-study, that does not mean you automatically receive those funds.
- Campus Service is similar, but for our international students.
