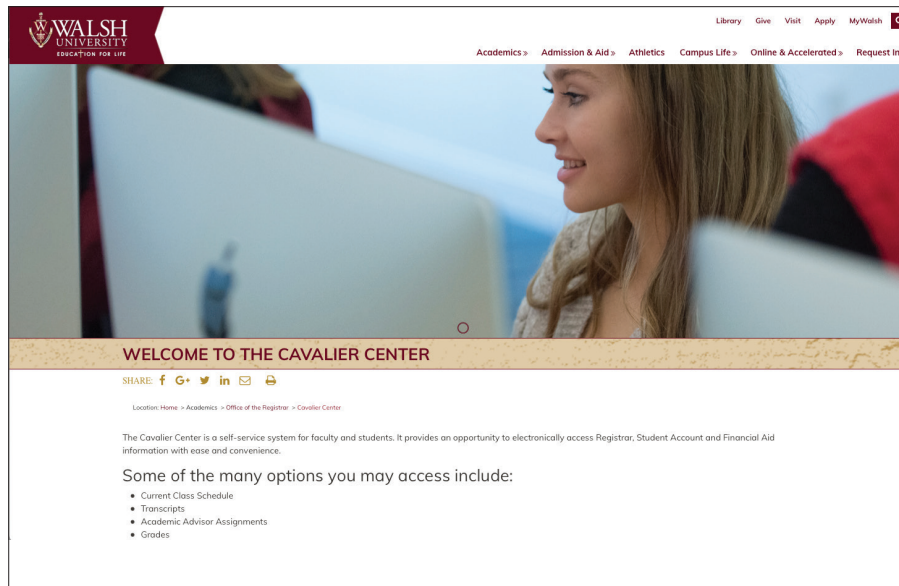


THE NEXT STEP...

1. Submit your tuition deposit online to get your Walsh email credentials. Visit Walsh.edu and select the Admissions tab to make your deposit.
2. Complete the next step of the financial aid awarding process by logging in to the Cavalier Center located within our Walsh University website

To access Walsh University's **CAVALIER CENTER**, simply go to:
www.walsh.edu/cavalier-center



Click on the **ACCESS THE CAVALIER CENTER** button and proceed to the **ALTERNATE LOG IN AREA** to the right of the screen.

Click and follow the log in directions.

While in the Secure Area of the Cavalier Center, you will be able to do the following:

- Accept terms and conditions
- Accept/Decline your financial aid award(s)
- View if anything is needed to complete your financial aid file
- View Information about our payment plan (see the enclosed half sheet)
- Complete the FERPA Release in order for a parent or guardian to be able to discuss your account

Please remember that the financial aid awarding process will not be considered complete until you access The Cavalier Center

Review your Financial Aid Offer

- Follow the Cavalier Center Next Steps on the other side of this flier.
- Decide on your self-help aid by accepting, partially accepting, or declining your federal student loans.
- Payments can be made online at www.walsh.edu/payments and are due by the first Monday after school starts.
- Be sure to check for any unsatisfied financial aid requirements in your Cavalier Center; Select Student > On the top left select Banner > Financial Aid > Financial Aid > Home > Student Requirements.
- Setup your refund preference on Nelnet.
- Sign up for a 3–6-month payment plan to split up your balance into smaller payments. For a 6-month payment plan the last day to register for the Fall semester is June 20th and Spring semester is December 20th. Sign up at mycollegepaymentplan.com/walsh-university.

If Borrowing a Federal Direct Subsidized or Unsubsidized Loan

1. **Complete Entrance Loan counseling** - This is a requirement for any new students who are taking out federal student loans. This may take you up to 30 minutes. Our office will receive this electronically in 24-48 hours. Go to studentaid.gov > log in with Your FSA ID > hover over Complete Aid Process > Complete Entrance Counseling > Start. You will select which entrance counseling you are completing on the first screen.
2. **Sign your Master Promissory Note** - This is required by the government to confirm understanding of paying back loans. This will seem like an application as there are questions regarding references. Our office will receive this electronically in 24-48 hours. Go to studentaid.gov > log in with FSA ID > hover over Complete Aid Process > select the MPN that applies to your situation.

If Applying for an additional loan

1. **Parent PLUS Loan** - This loan is in the parent's name and requires a credit check. Go to studentaid.gov > log in with the Parent's FSA ID > hover over Apply for Aid > select Apply for a Parent PLUS Loan > click Start. Choose correct term based on semesters enrolled. Increase loan amount by 4.3% for origination fee charged at disbursement. Once completed, it will show credit status.
If denied: pursuing an endorser may later approve the loan or choosing not to pursue the PLUS loan will give the student additional Direct Unsubsidized loan eligibility.
2. **Alternative Loan** - This loan is typically in the student's name and will need a co-signer. Alternative Parent Loan options are also available. Visit www.elmselect.com to compare loans.

Complete the FERPA Release of Education Record Information form online

1. From your Cavalier Center account select Walsh E-Forms > Forms > FERPA Release of Education Record Information Form
2. Make sure to select either "All information shown below can be released", or to include "Financial Aid, Tuition Charges, and Payments, Refunds Issued" in order for a parent or guardian to be able to reach out to the Student Service Center to discuss your account.
