

Master of Occupational Therapy Program: Traditional Early Assurance

High school applicants or currently qualified undergraduates must be accepted into Walsh University Psychology Pre-OT or Exercise Science Pre-OT major, have a high school GPA of a 3.3 or higher and complete a standardized interview with program faculty.

Master of Occupational Therapy applicants must complete pre-requisite courses with a GPA of at least 3.3, and maintain an overall GPA of at least 3.3, during their undergraduate coursework.

Complete these items for application review process:

- ☐ Complete the Academic History section in Slate, including all institutions attended.
- ☐ Submit an official transcript from each institution attended, sent from the registrar to Slate with the transcript matching form enclosed..
- ☐ Submit 3 **Letters of Recommendation** from individuals (e.g., instructor, employer, supervisor, or coach) who have known the applicant for at least one year.
- ☐ Submit signed **Observation Form** of a minimum of 20 observation hours across at least two sites, by a licensed occupational therapist or occupational therapy assistant.
- ☐ Submit **Personal Statement** through Slate.
- ☐ Submit signed **Technical Standards Form** through Slate.
- ☐ Continue to log in to Slate regularly to monitor the real-time status of transcript verification and reference completion, as follow-up may be required.
