

Master of Occupational Therapy Program: Traditional Pathway

Applicants must have a bachelor's degree (completed or in progress), and complete prerequisite courses with a minimum GPA of 3.0.

Complete these items for application review process:

- ☐ Complete the Academic History section in OTCAS, including all institutions attended.
- ☐ Submit an official transcript from each institution attended, sent from the registrar to OTCAS with the transcript matching form enclosed.
- ☐ Enter coursework into OTCAS (coursework should not be entered from memory, as discrepancies may delay verification).
- ☐ Submit 3 **Letters of Recommendation** from individuals (e.g., instructor, employer, supervisor, or coach) who have known the applicant for at least one year.
- ☐ Submit signed **Observation Form** through OTCAS of a minimum of 20 observation hours across at least two sites, by a licensed occupational therapist or occupational therapy assistant.
- ☐ Submit **Personal Statement** through OTCAS.
- ☐ Submit signed **Technical Standards Form** through OTCAS.
- ☐ Submit **Readiness Inventory** in OTCAS.
- ☐ Continue to log in to OTCAS regularly to monitor the real-time status of transcript verification and reference completion, as follow-up may be required.
