APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION TO THE TEACHER PREPARATION PROGRAM

Students pursuing a teaching license must apply for acceptance into the Walsh University Teacher Preparation Program. Applications for Teacher Preparation are usually made at the end of the sophomore year and acceptance is necessary for students to register for 300 and 400 level education courses, pre-student teaching, and student teaching. Application deadlines are in October, February, and rolling admissions through August and will be announced via email to all education students. Students will be notified in writing of their admission status:

- Approved
- Conditionally Approved
- Denied

A student who is denied admission to Teacher Preparation will not be permitted to enroll in 300/400 level education classes and may:

- Decide to pursue a non-licensure program
- Correct and verify area(s) of deficiency and re-apply at a later date
- Appeal to the Division of Education Teacher Candidate Development Committee
- Appeal to the Associate Vice President of Academic Affairs and Dean of Instruction (if Education appeal is denied and student wants to further pursue the issue)
