Students pursuing a teaching license must apply for acceptance into the Walsh University Teacher Preparation Program. Application deadlines are in October, February, and rolling admissions through August and will be announced via email to all education students. - Appeal to the Associate Vice President of Academic Affairs and Dean of Instruction (if Education appeal is denied and student wants to further pursue the issue)
