	 At least 5 days have passed since symptoms first appeared; <u>AND</u>, At least 24 hours have passed since recovery - defined as resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications and improvement in overall symptoms. If asymptomatic, individual will isolate for 5 days from the date of the test. Written approval to return from COVID-19 Response Team will be required prior to return. Individual must wear mask around others for 5 additional days upon return.
