Walsh University Campus Police

Maintenance Emergencies

Apartment Keys

Each guest is issued two keys at check-in: a building key and a bedroom key. Your individual room will be noted on the envelope containing your keys. The guest is responsible for any costs associated with lost, stolen, or damaged keys. The replacement cost is \$100 per key. We appreciate your efforts to return keys in their original envelope.

Lockouts

If you are locked out of your room, please call Campus Police. Please be aware that there could be up to a 15-minute wait for the staff person to arrive

Amenities

The apartments do not have any amenities like sheets, towels and toiletries.

Cleaning

Walsh University will not clean the apartment during your stay.

Trash Disposal

We would ask that you please dispose of your trash. A small trash cart is located on the ground floor of the apartment.

Smoking/Tobacco

Smoking is not permitted in any Walsh University Residence Hall or on University Apartment balconies. The Betzler Courtyard (located in the center of the University Apartments) is considered a designated smoking area as cigarette receptacles are clearly visible.
