How to Get Started (Note: The entire application process takes 30-60 days)

- ☐ Complete an online application for admission to the Walsh University
- □ Request Transcripts
 - Send official military, high school and college (if applicable) transcripts directly to Walsh University
 - Request your Joint Service Transcript (JST) by clicking here (Army, Coast Guard, Marine Corps and Navy)
 - Request Air Force transcripts through the Community College of the Air Force
 - Email all transcripts to admissionsdocuments@walsh.edu

☐ Apply for U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) Education Benefits

- Go to VA.gov to submit your VA Certificate of Eligibility (COE). Please note, this process typically takes 30 days.
 Walsh University does not penalize with late fees and can back date up to a year
- ☐ Apply for U.S. Department of Defense Tuition Assistance (TA) Benefits
 - Typically, active duty military or dependents are eligible for TA benefits
- ☐ Apply for Financial Aid (FAFSA)
 - Federal Tuition Assistance Programs are a benefit paid to eligible members of the Air Force, Army, Coast Guard,
 Marines and Navy. Request Federal Tuition Assistance (TA) benefits through your <u>branch education portal</u>
- □ Utilize the GI Bill® Comparison Tool for housing allowance rates and school tuition coverages
