Program Outcomes Report 2021-2022

Clinical Mental Health Counseling (CMHC) Program

In this reporting period (through end of Summer 2022) 21 students graduated. The completion rate of students from the CMHC program was 100%. This completion rate includes both CMHC students and Dual students (those completing both the CMHC and SC [School Counseling] or SAHE [Student Affairs in Higher Education] specializations). CMHC students had a 100% pass rate on the NCE for initial licensure. The job placement rate of graduates from the CMHC (and Dual) program (i.e. those who were actively seeking employment) was also 100%.

School Counseling (SC) Program

In this reporting period (through end of Summer 2022) 5 students graduated. The completion rate of students from the School Counseling program was 100%. The pass rate for the ODE (Ohio Department of Education) in Academic Year 2020-2021 was 83%. This rate includes all SC students completing the program who took the School Counseling licensure exam in the state of Ohio within this reporting period. The job placement rate of graduates from the SC program (i.e., those who were actively seeking employment) was 79%.
