As noted in the announcement to the community, Dr. Rick Artman, search consultant from Academic Search, will visit the campus Wed-Friday, Feb. 27 – Mar. 1. The purpose of his visit is to listen and to learn as much as he can about Walsh that will result in his preparing a search prospectus for a national recruitment strategy. The prospectus will include facts and features about the university, the position, candidate requirements and qualifications, and other information.

In conjunction with The Honorable Sara Lioi, Chair of the Walsh University Board of Directors, I am scheduling varied appointments for Dr. Artman to meet with the search committee and many constituents. Some meetings will be with individuals, some with small groups, and others will be open forums for faculty, administration, and staff. 1. What would attract quality candidates to apply for the presidency at Walsh University. In other words, what are our strengths and attractive features?
2. What are the most significant challenges and opportunities facing the president?
3. What are the academic and experiential requirements for the next president?
4. What are the qualifications and attributes that you value in the next president?
5. What are the priorities that should drive the agenda of the next president in the first 18-24 months?

Your thoughtful preparation will make the best use of limited time available for these meetings.
